The Great Chili Cook-Off will be open to the first 30 participants to register. Registration information will be included in your August PSL summer information mailing, as well as in your late summer Evite. Watch for it!

In the meantime, here are a few things to keep in mind if you'd like to compete:

- ◆ Chili must be prepared at home under sanitary conditions. The only restriction on ingredients, in keeping with Mirman School policy, is that nuts are not permitted. Use of meats, beans, pasta, vegetables, spices and other ingredients are up to you.
- ◆ You will be asked to make enough chili to fill the two aluminum pans supplied with your registration materials (pans are ½ size). You must use the supplied pans.
- ◆ An ingredient list, chili-spice-rating, and chili “title” will be required with each entry. Chefs will remain anonymous to encourage unbiased voting.
- ◆ Official chili tasting and voting will take place from 5:00pm to 6:00pm at the Mirman Western-Style Family Picnic on Saturday, September 12th. Voting will be done by the Mirman community in attendance.
- ◆ Chili cook-off participants must arrive no later than 4:30pm with their chili completely cooked and warm in the supplied aluminum pans on the day of the event.
