



# PARTY BOOK 2010-2011

## Party Policies

1. Parties are for Mirman School families only.
2. Reservations will not be accepted from anyone under 18 years of age.
3. Click once on the “Register to Reserve Party Space(s)” link at the top. You will be asked for your contact and billing information. In addition, you will be asked to create a password and your email address will now be your user name for access to the Party Book site .
4. Payments must be made by on-line at time of purchase by credit card. The credit card number, card holder name, authorization code, and expiration date will be requested.
5. Your reservation will be confirmed via e-mail.
6. If a party is full, there may be a waiting list at the discretion of the host and Mirman School Party Book Committee. If available, click on the link provided to add your name to the waiting list.
7. **Payment is non-refundable.** In the event of rain or extenuating circumstances, the host(s) may at his/her discretion reschedule or cancel the party. If such circumstances arise, hosts will do their best to reschedule the event. If the party is cancelled or if you are unable to attend, your payment will be considered a donation to the Mirman School Parents’ Service League.
8. You will be contacted by your host(s) prior to each event to confirm details.

Mirman makes no representation or warranty regarding any event, including, without limitation, the availability or sufficiency of any insurance coverage in connection with such event. Purchaser releases and holds Mirman harmless for such damage and liability.

## Party Book Pass Policy:

To welcome new Mirman families to the community and to encourage participation in Party Book, we are pleased to issue Party Passes to families joining the Mirman community for the first time for the 2010-2011 school year.

### How the Party Pass works:

- (1) Each new family gets one (1) Party Pass, to be applied to a party. The Party Pass can only be redeemed on [www.mirmanparties.com](http://www.mirmanparties.com) <<http://www.mirmanparties.com/>> and cannot be used for any other Mirman School activities, websites, or invoices.
- (2) Each Party Pass has a maximum value of \$50.00. If the new family chooses to apply the Party Pass to a party that costs less than \$50.00, then the difference between \$50.00 and the cost of the party chosen is forfeited. If the new family chooses to use the Party Pass for a party that costs more than \$50.00, the new family is responsible for paying the difference between the cost of the party and \$50.00.
- (3) There are a limited number of Party Passes that are available for each party, as determined by the Party Book Co-chairs. Some parties may not be eligible for Party Passes.
